

Linguistic Policy

In order to ensure high-quality mobility activities with maximum impact on mobility participants, the College of Applied Sciences Užice will provide the necessary linguistic support to both outgoing and incoming staff and students. The support will be provided free of charge.

The College offers three foreign language courses to students in all study programmes: English, French and Russian. Our language teachers are responsible for the preparation of participants for mobility.

Prior to mobility, placement tests will be organised to determine the language level of each outgoing Erasmus candidate in compliance with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages, and based on the results, intensive language courses will be delivered. Courses can be both college-based and delivered online, using the Moodle e-learning platform.

After the completion of the mobility period, additional language testing will be organized in order to determine to what degree the mobility has contributed to the outgoing participant's foreign language proficiency.

All our study programmes are accredited in the Serbian language. Therefore, inbound mobility participants will be offered an intensive Serbian language course, which will be organized with the help of Serbian language teachers employed in high schools in Užice. The desired Serbian language level is B1.

In addition to the Serbian language course, all inbound participants will be assigned peer mentors, i.e. teachers and students with high-level proficiency in foreign languages to assist them during the whole period of mobility.
