These are the guidelines how to prepare a paper for the proceedings of the 3rd SED 2010. They are written in the format that is being described. Please follow these instructions.

2. TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

It is possible to write the paper in English language only (Times New Roman – TNR 10 pt normal).

Writing technique: text editor MS Word 95 or upgraded.

The length of the paper is limited to **6 (six) pages**.

For the paper to be published it is necessary to send: in paper form printed on the laser printer and diskette by regular mail or in electronic form by e-mail: sed@vpts.edu.rs. Deadline for full paper submission is **15. September 2010.**

Announcement to the authors of accepting the paper and the final program will be sent until **01. October 2010.**

2.1. Format

Preferably use A4 (297x210 mm²) page (by ISO 216 and ISO 478) format with margins (mm): 25 top, bottom, left and right.

2.2. Tables

Each table is numbered and table captions are in TNR 10 pt, placed above the table, centered and have the following style.

2.3. Figures

Figures should be numbered. Please do not insert text boxes over the figures. Figure caption is in TNR 10 pt, placed below the figure, centered and has the following style:

Equations are left justified 5 mm from left with equation number at the right margin in font TNR 10 pt Italic.
